DJ BARRY CUP PLAYING CONDITIONS 2023

note: ANY part of the following document may be superseded by the contents of the <u>Senior</u> <u>Competition Regulations</u> of the Northern Districts Cricket Association, at the discretion of the Competition Manager or quorum amongst the PBCA Committee.

Matches are to be played on consecutive Saturdays, with the exception of the Final - which will be played over a single weekend.

80 MINIMUM overs per day - 1:00pm start, 7.30pm finish maximum hours.

- Three sessions:
 - SESSION 1: 1pm 3:00pm 29 overs minimum
 Lunch (20 minutes)
 - SESSION 2: 3:20pm 5:20pm 29 overs minimum
 Tea (20 Minutes)
 - SESSION 3: 5:40pm 7:10pm 22 overs minimum
- *10-minute (3-over) allowance for change of innings
- mandatory 1st innings declaration (for both teams) at 60 overs
- MINIMUM of 80 overs per day
- MAXIMUM of 96 overs per day (first class)
- final over in the day's play must start by 7:30pm, no later
- 5-run penalty per over lost in each bowling innings, at the umpire's discretion, based on a schedule of 4 minutes per over, from the start of each innings

The playing 12 for each team must be named BEFORE the toss on Day 1.

This may include a non-batter and non-bowler. The non-batter and non-bowler may NOT change for Day 2, UNLESS they are being replaced. The replacement must take their role - as a non-batter, or non-bowler (e.g. 'like for like' replacement - you can NOT replace a non-batter with a non-bowler, or vice versa)

Changes to each team from week-to-week may occur, but the player/s being replaced MUST be named BEFORE the second day's play begins.

Any not-out batsman at the close of play on Day 1 who is named unavailable for Day 2 is considered retired and may NOT return to bat if they are nominated as a player being replaced.

A player listed on the team sheet in a DJ Barry Cup fixture for Day 1, but is named unavailable for Day 2, may NOT participate in a Hope Cup fixture on that same day.

A player graded to Hope Cup who is used on Day 1, MAY be replaced for Day 2, and play in the Hope Cup. If this player is a not-out batsman at the close of play on Day 1, they shall be considered 'retired out', and may not return to the DJ Barry Cup fixture.

Fielding:

No fielding restrictions.
